The planned transformation outlined in this document will ensure that it continues to deliver quality health care into the future as part of the Northern Sydney Local Health District.



Transforming Mona Vale Hospital

The transformation of Mona Vale Hospital is a key component of the Northern Beaches Health Service Redevelopment which aims to ensure the provision of high quality, appropriate and integrated health care services across the Northern Beaches.

When acute services transfer to the Northern Beaches Hospital in late 2018, opportunities will be created to transform the Mona Vale Hospital campus without impacting current service provision.

This will enable the hospital to progressively transform into a purpose built dynamic health care environment centred around a village green. It will ensure that the hospital plays a vital role in the provision of health services across the Northern Beaches and within the Northern Sydney Local Health District (NSLHD).



Planning for the Future

Registrations of Interest for health-related services

The NSW Government is now seeking Registrations of Interest from health care providers who can offer new additional services at Mona Vale Hospital that will complement those being delivered on the Northern Beaches and across the NSLHD.

It is anticipated that responses to the Registrations of Interest might include the following:

- day surgery
- primary care services including general practice
- family resource centre
- additional clinical support services, for example; medical imaging, pathology and pharmacy
- medical suites
- mental health
- additional oral health
- additional rehabilitation and sub-acute services
- residential care facilities
- carer accommodation.

Delivering the right services

The Registration of Interest process is designed to explore additional new services to complement those that are already provided at Mona Vale Hospital or are in the planning phase.

These include:

- a new Urgent Care Centre providing 24/7 services
- the Assessment Rehabilitation Unit
- the Beachside Rehabilitation Unit
- a hydrotherapy pool
- the Mona Vale Community Health Centre
- a Geriatric Evaluation and Management (GEM) unit
- inpatient palliative care
- ambulance service and helipad.

Networking health services across the Northern Beaches

Mona Vale Hospital will continue to deliver integrated services that complement those provided across the Northern Beaches.

These include:

- the new Northern Beaches Hospital at Frenchs Forest
- Dalwood Children's Services at Seaforth
- Mona Vale Community Health Centre
- Brookvale Community Health Centre

There will be a wider range of health services available to the local community than ever before.

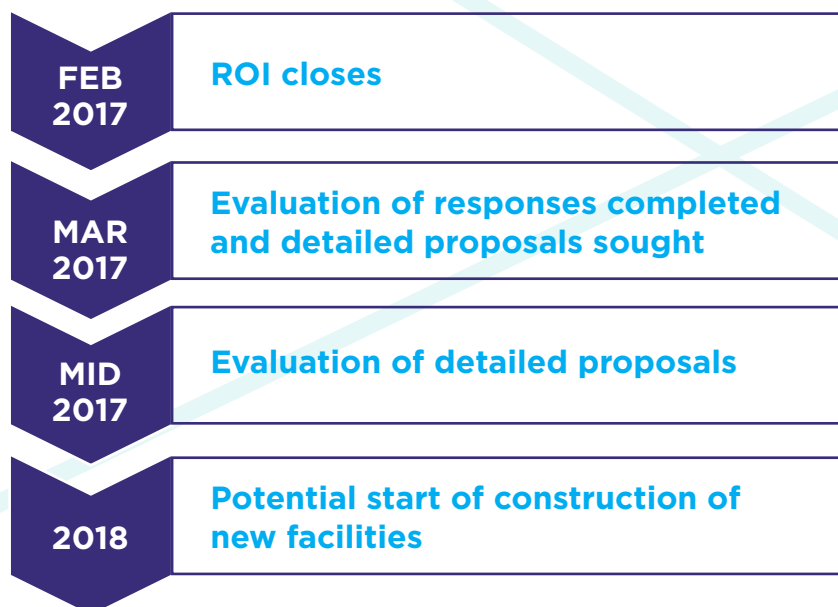


Next Steps

Through the Registration of Interest process, health care providers are being invited to outline the services they would be interested in delivering at Mona Vale Hospital.

After careful evaluation successful respondents will be asked to submit more detailed proposals.

Health care providers have until February 2017 to outline the potential services to be offered. Depending on the level of interest received the process is expected to follow this timetable.
